He is co-editor of 2 books, co-author of over 400 publications and 8 patents, and has received several national and international research awards. He is editor of ACS Omega, reviewing editor of Science and editorial advisory board member of several chemistry, nanotechnology and materials science journals. His current interests include nanoparticle synthesis and assembly, nanoplasmonics, and development of nanoparticle-based sensing and diagnostic tools, including SERS detection and imaging.
